Today, she has her own barn near Southern Pines and competes at Advanced level combined driving events (most recently winning the Advanced Single Horse division at Live Oaks in March). Marcie is an American Driving Society licensed judge and Technical Delegate, and chairs the ADS Combined Driving Committee. She also pens insightful articles for Driving Digest and other magazines.
