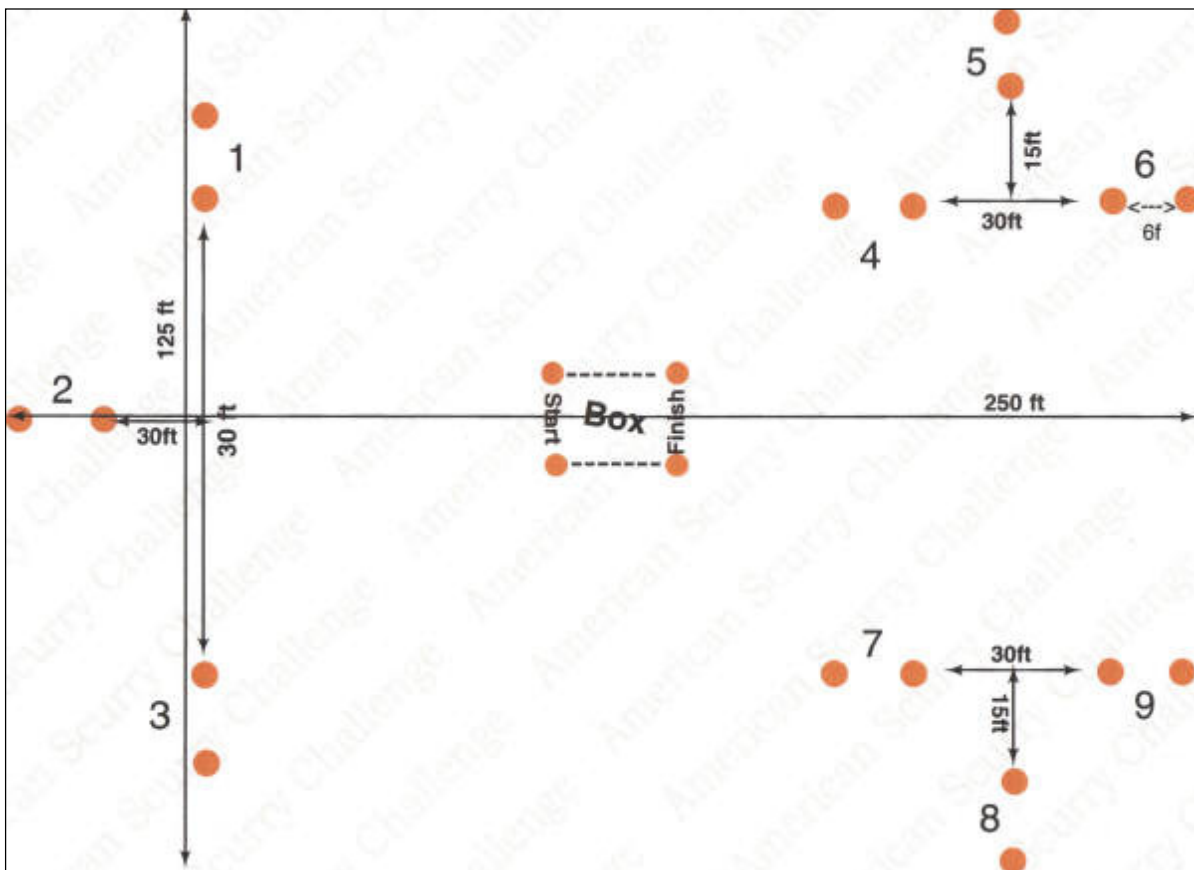


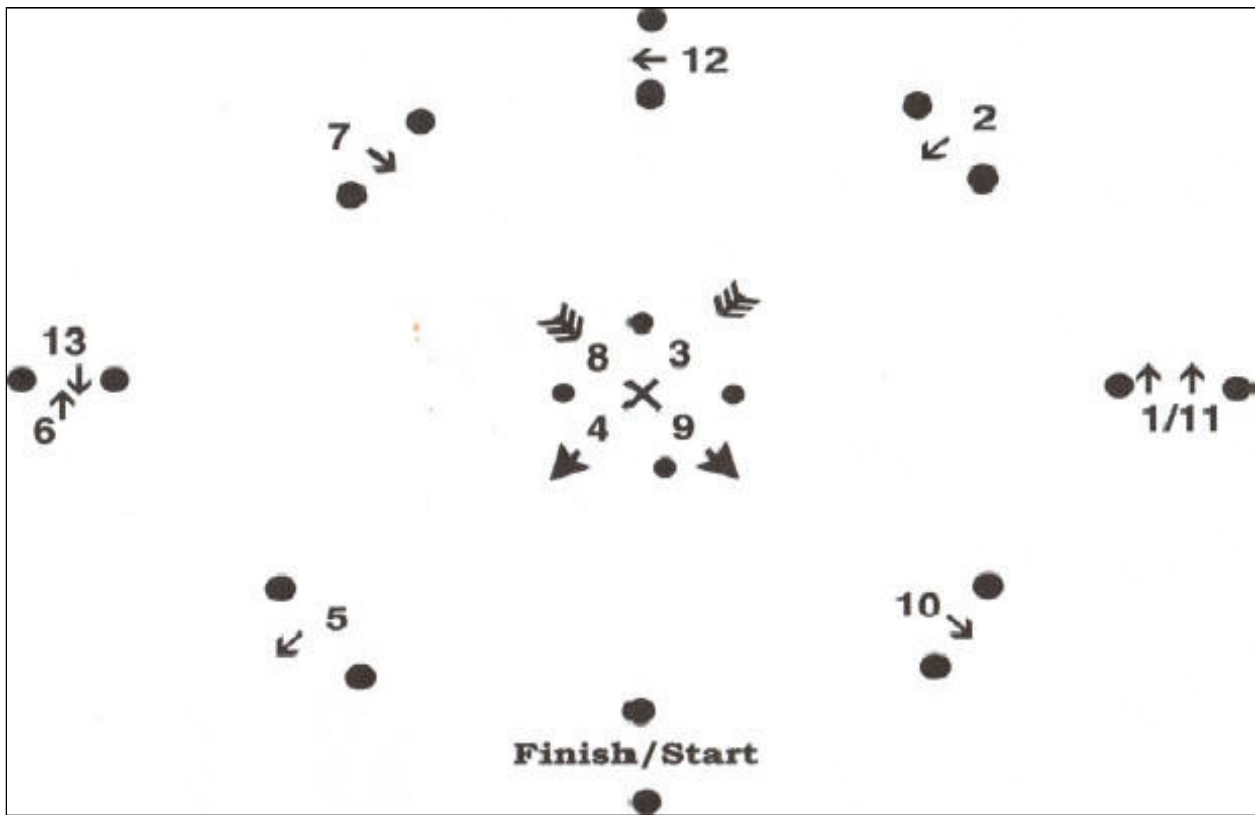
NOTES:

- You may drive at any pace, or stop, or back up.
- You may drive a 2 or 4 wheel vehicle of any variety.
- Navigators or grooms are not required, but if in the carriage and on course, they must stay seated and may not assist.
- Courses may be walked first, time and circumstances permitting.
- Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle or leaving an animal unattended while hitched anywhere on the grounds will result in ELIMINATION.
- Proof of Negative Coggins test within past 12 month.
- **HARD HATS are REQUIRED for anyone on the carriage while driving any of the Scurry Classes**
- The hay fields south of Rt. 82 may be available for pleasure driving, subject to the haying operation. We will let you know
- There is good parking for trailers next to the ring. After entering the gravel driveway to Mitchell Farm go about 100 yards, cross a small bridge and turn left through a wide gate into the parking area. Hopefully there will be someone to help you park.

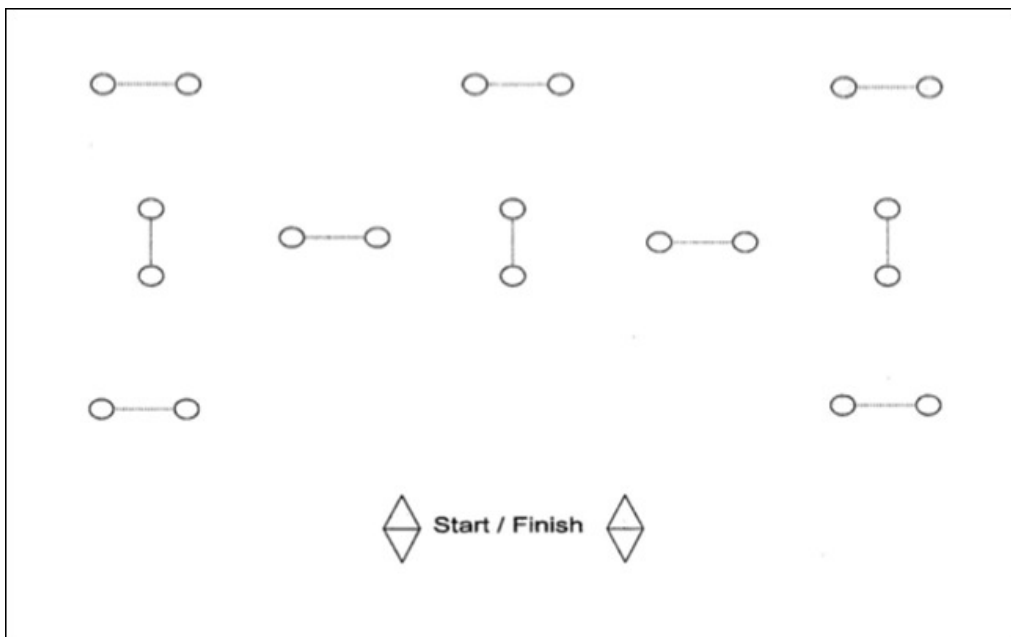
Course/Class 1: Start with full turnout standing inside the box. Exit box, drive the cones in order & return to the inside of the box (staying in box for 5 seconds) in the closest to the optimal time, without going under. Cones are set at 6' apart for all. Any ball down, off course, or leaving finish box early will result in an E for round. Each driver gets 2 runs. The time closest to optimal counts. *Optimal time is based on ADS pleasure show cones standards of 725 ft/min (i.e. good working trot) for singles and pairs and 590 ft/min for VSE. All cones are set 6 ft. apart. Numbers will be clearly visible and if followed in sequence the direction is obvious and navigation should not be a problem. Cones cannot be walked after the class has started.*



Course/Class 2: Cross the starting line to start your time. Drive the cones in order and cross the finish line to stop the clock. Each ball down = 2 seconds added to your time. Cones set at 6' for all. Each driver gets 2 runs, the faster time counts. There are 13 gates. Note that gates 1 & 11 and gates 6 & 13 each share one pair of cones. All cones are marked with numbers which are clearly visible from the previous cone. So again this course should be easy to navigate.



Course/Class 3: Pick your own route: Obstacles are not numbered and may be passed in either direction but each obstacle to be negotiated only once. All cones are set 6 ft. apart. After crossing the **Start** line, drive each obstacle choosing your own route and cross the finish line (in either direction) to stop the clock. Course faults are scored as two penalty seconds and are added to driver's elapsed time. There will be time to walk this course before the class starts. Two runs, the fastest time counts.
